



Rector Fr. Wilhelm Meyer is the Founder of the Society of Sisters of St. Ann, Luzern. He was born on September 12th 1870 in the village Schoetz at Luzern, Switzerland. He was a Roman Catholic Priest and was appointed as vice Rector of the Seminary in Luzern. His compassionate heart sensed the need of the suffering mothers who were dying at the time of child birth due to the unavailability of health care at that time, in Switzerland.

To respond to the need of the hour he founded a Religious Association of Sisters of St. Ann in the year 1909 under the powerful protection of St. Ann. Having instilled the spirit of Self Sacrifice in the lives of sisters, he empowered them to set the world on fire with the Missionary Zeal. Within a couple of years, after founding the Society, in the year 1912 he left the world due to Carcinoma (cancer). The sisters, slowly moved towards India in the year 1927, and began their missionary activities later to different continents.


NOTE:- It is mandatory to clear the school fee by the end of Academic Year to obtain promotion to the next class

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS, RULES AND CODE OF CONDUCT

- The School is opened to pupils of all Communities and Religions.
- Absentees will not be allowed to attend class without producing valid reasons in the 'Leave Record'.
- All the students are expected to be present on the Re- Opening days of Diwali, Christmas and Summer Vacations. Leave will not be sanctioned on the Re- Opening days.
- After 15 days of continuous absence without intimation, the absentee's name will be struck off in the register. If re- admitted they should pay admission fee.
- Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, neglect of homework, disobedience and disrespect towards the members of the staff or bad moral influence will not be justified.
- Any damage done to the school property will be made good by the one who has done it.
- Students must be up-to-date in their work; eg. Completion of homework, studying for the slip tests etc.
- Pupils must supply themselves with all necessary books and stationery before the reopening the school.
- Pupils themselves are responsible for their books, pen, tiffin carriers or any other articles they may bring to school. They are not allowed to wear jewellery.
- Pupils absent from examination without genuine reasons and prior permission will be considered as absent. Absentees from any examination will not be re-examined.
- School uniform, is mandatory for all.

- At the first bell in the morning all the pupils should be present for the assembly.
- No text books, note books or other papers are to be brought into the examination hall. Students found copying or using unfair means during the examination will be dealt seriously.
- The progress of pupils tested by means of tests and terminal examinations. The results of these are communicated to the parents by progress cards.
- Parents/Guardians and others may not see the students or interview the teachers during school hours
- Parents are encouraged to visit the school **every Second Saturday** for Parent-Teacher meeting, to discuss the progress of their children with the teachers and not any other days.
- For any matter related to a student, only parents or legal guardians are permitted to communicate with the school administration. No third party shall be entertained under any circumstances.
- Parent or guardians are expected to bring lice complaints if any, to the Principal or the class teacher.
- School diary should be brought to school every day, if a pupil loses his/her copy, he/she should buy a new one.
- **Fees once paid will not be refunded.**
- The students and parents are strictly requested to abide by the rules of the institution.
- The school will appreciate the co-operation of the parents for the day-to-day progress of their children.
- Parents are the teachers of the students at home. They should take their responsibility very seriously, to guide their children personally.
